

Acquaghiaccia

The country house is located at the center of a small green valley and is part of an estate called "Le grotte", set within the 20 hectares of forest that surrounds it. It has its own natural spring from which the Acquaghiaccia Guest House takes its name.

The beautiful, natural setting of Acquaghiaccia, the olive trees and surrounding chestnut forest,

rich with mushrooms, asparagus and wildlife, makes this a wonderful place to visit in any season. Acquaghiaccia can be described as an enchanting oasis in Umbria because of its prime position, situated in one of Italy's most unspoiled regions between Baschi and Todi which can be reached following a historical scenic route.
